TAX-FREE CHARITABLE IRA GIFTS



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The IRA Charitable Rollover provision was signed into law in 2015.

As you plan your giving and are considering a tax-free rollover gift from your IRA to SSM Health Cardinal Glennon Children's Foundation, below is a summary the legislative provisions.

You must be 70 ½ years of age or older when the distribution is made. The transfer must go directly from your IRA to SSM Health Cardinal Glennon Children's Foundation. You may make tax-free transfers from your IRA to a charity or charities totaling up to \$100,000 in a given calendar year. Your spouse also may be eligible to make such gifts up to \$100,000 from his or her IRA.



A charitable rollover transfer from your IRA will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

Since IRA funds are not being taxed, it is the equivalent of a full income tax deduction. Gifts from an IRA may only be used to make an outright gift to a qualified public charity. Your IRA assets cannot be used to fund a gift annuity, charitable remainder trust, a donor advised fund or a private foundation.
